The Village of Dwight will hold a public hearing on Tuesday August 18, 2026, at 6:30 p.m., in Dwight Village Hall, to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federal funded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project. Persons with disabilities or non-English speaking persons who wish to attend the public hearing and need assistance should contact the North Central Illinois Council of Governments (NCICG), 613 W. Marquette St., Ottawa, IL (815) 433-5830 no later than August 13, 2026. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

On or about August 27, 2026, the Village of Dwight intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant from the State CDBG program. This program is funded by Title 1 of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: grant administration, construction supervision, and housing rehabilitation of 10 owner-occupied, single-family homes in the project area of; the Village Limits of Dwight. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$800,000. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low-to-moderate income persons is \$800,000. The Village of Dwight also proposes to expend \$20,000 in non-CDBG funds on the project. The \$20,000 non-CDBG funds will be derived from the following sources: Streator Onized Credit Union \$5,000, Peoples National Bank of Kewanee Dwight Banking Center \$5,000, Bank of Pontiac \$5,000, Midland States Bank \$5,000.

The Village of Dwight will hold a public hearing on August 18, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at Village Hall, 209 South Prairie Avenue, Dwight, Illinois, to provide interested parties an opportunity to comment on the Village's proposed Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Community Revitalization application. Persons with disabilities or non-English speaking persons requiring assistance should contact Crissy Livingston, Village Administrator, at (815) 584-3077 no later than 10:00 a.m. on August 18, 2026, so reasonable accommodations can be made.

On or about August 31, 2026, the Village of Dwight intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) for funding through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, authorized under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.

The proposed project includes the rehabilitation and repurposing of the former Stevenson Pool Bathhouse and the reconstruction of the adjacent public parking lot and associated site improvements. The rehabilitated bathhouse will provide ADA-accessible restrooms, renovated locker rooms, storage, and support spaces for the Village's planned Route 66-themed splash pad while also serving visitors to Renfrew Park. The parking lot improvements include new pavement, sidewalks, curb and gutter, ADA accessibility improvements, storm sewer infrastructure, lighting, landscaping, and striping to improve safety, accessibility, and public access to the park. Together, these improvements will restore an important public facility, enhance recreational amenities, and improve access for residents and visitors.

The total amount of CDBG funds requested is \$903,428.00. The estimated amount of CDBG funds that will benefit low-to-moderate income persons is \$495,981.98.

Project information will be available for public review beginning August 7, 2026, at Village Hall, 209 South Prairie Avenue, Dwight, Illinois, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
